RAISING A CONCERN WITH SCHOOL...

Occasionally, parents or carers may have concerns or worries they wish to address with school, this may be to do with academic progress, social interactions or a situation at home.

In such circumstances we ask parents & carers to observe the following procedure...

1. Inform the class teacher by a phone call, letter or make an appointment to speak with them. Most often issues are resolved quickly at this stage.
2. Speak with the Vice Principal (Mrs Lowry).
3. If the issue is still not resolved speak with Mrs Hall. By following a staged approach, we can ensure that your concern is heard by more than one person and our goal is to resolve issues quickly. It may be necessary for the teacher to return your call as they have teaching responsibilities throughout the day.
