PERIOD DIGNITY

The Department of Education is rolling out to all schools - both primary and post primary information and support on a scheme called Period Dignity. One of the aims of the scheme is to reduce the stigma and taboo in relation to periods and recognise that this is a natural part of growing-up. In school we have children who mature at different rates and some girls start their periods as young as 8 or 9 years old. We want to support all our learners in a caring and respectful way. Part of the Period Dignity Scheme is to provide free sanitary products to people who need them, these will be available in the school. Mrs Lowry will act as the Period Dignity Key Contact.
